**Mehiel opens HQ
in congressional bid**

Dennis Mehiel, who is seeking the Democratic nomination in the 19th Congressional District, has opened campaign headquarters in his hometown of Armonk and announced several appointments to his campaign staff.

Ian E. O'Neill of Bedford will manage the campaign, directing its daily strategy. Fund-raising director is Nicholas A. Biondi of Armonk. Willy Gissen of White Plains will be operations director, and Eric Inlaw of Ossining is coordinating community outreach.

Voter contact is being handled by Mohegan Lake's Jeff Barrett and Croton-on-Hudson's Norm Jacknis; Gary Richardson of Beacon is responsible for

advance work. The campaign's executive director is Gene Matusow of North Castle.
